

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL
JANUARY 18, 2009
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met at Oakland City Hall and was called to order by Mayor Michael O'Brien at 6:00P.M. Council Members present were Newberg, Miller, Rollins, Wede and Hackett. Also present were Public Works Director Mike Baragary, Assistant City Clerk Lucia Kinnison, and Doug Reed and Kenny Moore with the Oakland Fire Department. Motion by Hackett, second by Miller to approve the agenda. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Mayor O'Brien said he wanted to add discussion on personnel.

Discussion was held on amending the minutes from the January 11, 2010. Council decided to rescind motion and leave minutes as is and make it a resolution and vote on it at the next Council meeting.

The City Council discussed the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

Discussion was held on the Fire Department's budget for FY11.

Moore and Reed left.

The Council continued discussing the City budget and possible projects and expenses that would need to be included.

Mayor O'Brien brought up an issue of City Employee, Michael Baragary giving another City employee instructions to go outside City limits and pull a school bus out of a driveway. O'Brien stated that per State Code 68B.2A, it is a serious misdemeanor to use City equipment for personal gain. He read code that said that Michael Baragary had committed a criminal offense and should be severely reprimanded. He said that the Council had already discussed it and wanted to know what should be done about it. Newberg asked who the bus driver was and was told it was Tim White. Newberg said that it was for the school and his concern was about the liability of the City, which we should check with the insurance company. Several Council members stated that they did not believe it was for personal gain. There was discussion that the City had helped the school buses in the past. Council directed Mayor to write letter to the Superintendent stating that the City can no longer help the school in this regard.

Motion by Wede, second by Rollins to adjourn. 5 Ayes, motion carried.
