

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL
MARCH 23, 2010
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met at Oakland City Hall and was called to order by Mayor Michael O'Brien at 5:34P.M. Council Members present were Wede, Rollins, Miller, Hackett and Newberg. Also present were Public Works Director Mike Baragary, City Clerk Marissa Lockwood. Motion by Hackett, second by Miller to approve the agenda. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Miller, second by Wede to approve the Liquor License for Schettler Golf, Inc. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Newberg moved to approve the payment of the prorated general and liability premium for April 1-June 30 due to the change in renewal date to July 1, in the amount of \$11,199. Second by Hackett. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Newberg asked Baragary if the storage building in the park was still moving forward. Baragary stated he would get with the contractor and see when he could get it started. The trees along the highway were discussed. Mayor O'Brien said there are some places where trees have died and discussed asking the park board to see about replacing them.

Mayor O'Brien updated the Council members on the meeting with Dr. Sutton concerning agreements for helping each other. The school will check with their insurance company to see if they would hold the City and City employees harmless if there was an agreement established. O'Brien also discussed the property line at the swimming pool. There are water and sewer lines that the school wants to make sure gets mentioned in an easement if that is what the City and school agree to do.

Attorney Ray Aranza entered at 5:42P.M.

Motion by Wede, second by Hackett to enter into closed session pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 21.5 Section c. 5 Ayes, motion carried. Council entered closed session at 5:43P.M. Council returned to regular session at 7:02P.M. Motion by Hackett, second by Rollins to authorize Attorney Ray Aranza to negotiate with Bane's attorney to reach a settlement for the pending litigation. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Wede to adjourn. Second by Newberg. 5 Ayes, motion carried.
