City Wide Clean-up will be Thursday, April 28th through Sunday, May 1st, 2011. Dumpsters will be located on Dr. Thompson Avenue. Dumpsters will be dumped throughout those days.

There will be a trailer for metal only.

Tires, microwaves and computers will NOT be accepted.

#### OTHER CLEAN UP NEWS:

**Garbage:** Every resident is allowed 6—32 gallon cans per week. They shall be fitted with fly-tight lids. **Larger cans** will not be picked up. Garbage must be put out prior to **6 a.m.**



**Yard Waste:** can be disposed of at the **City Compost pile** located 1/4 mile west of town on G42. This is **only for grass clippings, leaves, and weeds.** Bags must be bio-degradable.

**PLEASE RECYCLE:** If you need new recycle bins, they can be picked up at City Hall.

<p><b><u>IMPORTANT REMINDER!!! BUILDING NUMBERING IS REQUIRED!!</u></b></p> <p><b>Per Ordinance No. 150.02</b> Owner Requirements. Every owner shall comply with the following numbering requirements:</p> <p><b>2. Display Building Number.</b> The owner shall place or cause to be installed and maintained on the principal building the assigned number in a conspicuous place to the street in figures not less than three (3) inches in height and of a contrasting color with their background.</p>		 <p><b><u>ANIMAL NUSIANCES</u></b></p> <p><b>City Ordinance 55.06 “At Large Prohibited.</b> It is unlawful for any owner to allow a dog to run at large within the corporate limits of the City.”</p>
<p><b><u>BUILDING PERMITS</u></b></p> <p>Are you going to be building within City limits or be buying or building a storage shed? If so, you will most likely need a building permit.</p> <p>Call or stop by City Hall to obtain a building permit application.</p>	<p><b><u>PARK SAFETY !</u></b></p> <p><b>REMINDER TO PARENTS!</b></p> <p><b>Please make sure that your children are supervised when playing in the park.</b></p>	<p><b>City Ordinance 55.08 “Annoyance or disturbance.</b> It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow or permit such dog to cause serious annoyance or disturbance to any person or persons by frequent and habitual howling, yelping, barking, or otherwise; or, by running after or chasing person, bicycles, automobiles or other vehicles.”</p>
<p><b><u>Automatic Withdrawal:</u></b></p> <p>You can have your bill automatically withdrawn from your checking account on the 15th of each month. You will continue to receive your normal bill and stub each month. This is available for any and all banks. Please contact City Hall to sign up.</p>	<p><b><u>Chautauqua Park Reservations</u></b></p> <p>Call City Hall at 482-6811 to reserve the shelter or ball fields for your event. There is <b><i>no cost.</i></b></p> <p><b>Also: <u>Call City Hall for Community Building Rentals.</u> Dates are available.</b></p>	<p><b>Impound Costs:</b> Impound costs are one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus the food and care charged by the veterinarian.</p> <p><b>(Please note:</b> proof of rabies and proof of license must be given before animal can be released.)</p>
<p><b><u>NOTICE TO BUSINESSES</u></b></p> <p>If you have a business website and would like to have it linked to the City Website , please contact City Hall.</p>		<p><b>City Ordinance 57.02 “PIT BULLS PROHIBITED.</b> It is unlawful for any person to own, possess, keep, exercise control over, maintain, harbor, transport, or sell any pit bull within the City except as provided herein.”</p> <p><b><u>PET LICENCES</u></b></p> <p>All owners of Cat(s) and Dog(s) over the age of six (6) months must procure a dog or cat license from the Clerk <b><i>on or before July 1st, each year.</i></b></p> <p><b>Fees:</b> \$3.00 for spayed or neutered. \$15.00 for non-spayed or neutered. Proof of Rabies is required before a license can be issued.</p>
