

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL
JULY 22, 2016
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Council Chambers and was called to order by Mayor Michael O'Brien at 6:00P.M. Council Members present were Newberg, Moniz, Miller, Perkins and Strickland. Also present were Public Works Director Mike Baragary, City Clerk Marissa Lockwood and Ken Moore.

Motion by Strickland, second by Miller to approve the agenda with the addition of discussion on the 4th of July celebration. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held with Ken Moore of Oakland Insurance Agency concerning the renewal of the general and liability insurance policy with ICAP. Moore was asked to review policy for changes every six months with city staff. Motion by Newberg to approve general and liability insurance renewal with ICAP in the amount of \$78,298.46. Second by Miller. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held on inflatable bounce houses for the 4th of July celebration.

Leak adjustment policy was discussed. No action was taken on adoption of the new leak adjustment policy. The City of Oakland's policy will remain as is, each leak will be addressed on an individual basis.

Dilapidated buildings were discussed. Exposed wall at 312 Oakland Avenue needs to be addressed by the property owner before damage from exposure to the elements occurs. Property at 316 Oakland Avenue has been sent letters in the past to do repairs and nothing has been done. Mayor directed Clerk to have attorney send letters to the property owners.

Motion by Strickland, second by Moniz to adjourn. 5 Ayes, motion carried.
