

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL
SEPTEMBER 28, 2015
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Council Chambers and was called to order by Mayor Michael O'Brien at 6:30P.M. Council Members present were Miller, Moniz, Newberg, Perkins and Smith. Also present was Public Works Director Mike Baragary, City Clerk Marissa Lockwood, Joyce Clark, Doris Bane, LaDonna Applegate, Helen Williams and Brad Wax. Motion by Newberg to approve the agenda, second by Perkins. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held on the design of the path and landscaping for the Pottawattamie County Freedom Rock. Applegate reported that the Pottawattamie County Community Foundation Grant is to be used by November 30, 2015 for concrete work. Brad Wax will draw up the design and O'Brien will write the specs to put the project out for bids. Bids will need to be in by October 12th and concrete work will need to be completed by November 16th.

Motion by Newberg to put the ambulance cot out for bids and to give Miller authority to reject any and/or all bids. Second by Smith. 4 Ayes, Miller abstained due to conflict of interest. Motion carried.

Engineer's designs for the intersection of Brown Street and Chautauqua Avenue were reviewed. Motion by Miller, second by Moniz to put option 1 for street closure/improvements of Chautauqua Avenue at the intersection of Brown Street out for bids. 5 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Miller to adjourn. Second Perkins. 5 Ayes, motion carried.
