SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Community Building and was called to order by Mayor Pro Tem Pat Newberg at 6:00P.M.. Council Members present were Newberg, Moniz, Miller and Smith. Also present was Public Works Director Mike Baragary, City Clerk Marissa Lockwood, members of the Oakland Industrial Foundation: Walt Keast, Phil Reed, Trevor Jefferson, Don Applegate, Jim Johnson, Alan Gardner, and Loree Hamilton; Lori Holste, Gayle Strckland and Helen Hummel. Motion by Moniz to approve the agenda, second by Miller. 4 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Miller to approve liquor license renewal for Oakland Country Club, second by Smith. 4 Ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Miller to set city wide cleanup dates for May 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> behind the City Shop at 218 Oakland Avenue. Second by Moniz. 4 Ayes, motion carried.

Oakland Industrial Foundation held their monthly business meeting.

Discussion was held between the City Council and the Oakland Industrial Foundation. Items discussed included potential housing development on Walnut Street, incentives for housing development, upcoming demolition of the building at 308-310 Oakland Avenue, developing a plan for the downtown, conducting a community input survey for what projects the residents and businesses would like to see take place, plans for the high school building, and the need for an industrial park. The City will be addressing the need for a new city attorney and conducting a community input survey at the regular City Council meeting on April 13<sup>th</sup>.
