Oakland Residents-

Effective June 1, 2020 at 8:00 AM, I hereby order the following COVID-19 restrictions currently in place within the City of Oakland to be relaxed or continue as follows:

- City Hall is open to the public during normal hours. Only one person at a time will be allowed at the Clerk's window. Anyone waiting to see the clerk is to remain outside or in the vestibule. Please read the information posted on the doors before entering the building. We encourage everyone to continue to conduct business by phone or email as much as possible.
- The fitness center will resume normal operating hours. We ask patrons to clean any equipment they use with the cleaning products provided. The occupancy should not exceed 5 people at one time. Please maintain social distancing of 6 feet while in the facility. City personnel will clean the fitness center on a daily basis. The shower facility will remain closed until further notice.
- The playground equipment in all parks will be open to the public. The playground equipment will not be disinfected by the city and those using it do so at their own risk. Patrons are asked to use good hygiene before and after use. The restroom facilities will remain closed unless arrangements have been made with public works with 24 hours notice.
- The Eckles Memorial Library is open their normal hours. The board has adopted a policy of one family at a time in the library. Please call ahead to schedule a time to enter the facility or check availability before you go.
- The Senior Center will remain closed until further notice.
- The Community Center will be open for events. Capacity is limited to 50% of the normal occupancy for the space being rented. Social distancing guidelines will apply. Please contact City Hall for more information.

All other rules and regulations in the Governor's Proclamation dated May 26, 2020 shall be adopted and enforced within the City of Oakland.

Please continue to practice good hygiene and social distancing when out in public.
