

OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL  
MAY 27, 2020  
SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met at the City Services Building and was called to order by Mayor Brant Miller at 5:00p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Council Members present were Newberg, Perkins, Reed, Rollins and Moniz. Also present was City Clerk Marissa Lockwood and Public Works Director Mike Baragary. Due to orders by Governor Reynolds concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, attendance at the location was limited to 10 people therefore a conference call-in number was provided to the public.

Motion by Moniz to approve the agenda with the addition of general discussion by Mayor Miller. Second by Perkins. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Lengthy discussion was held concerning opening of the swimming pool for the 2020 season. Only three lifeguard applications were received after advertising since March and extending the deadline three times. Motion was made by Newberg, seconded by Perkins to not open the swimming pool for the 2020 season due to not being able to safely operate the pool with so few lifeguards. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the Fourth of July celebration. City has been notified that Arbor Bank has cancelled the car show and the Chamber has decided not to be involved in the planning due to safety concerns during the coronavirus pandemic. Council decided to hold an organizational meeting Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00p.m. for anyone interested in getting involved in the Fourth of July celebration. Clerks will contact organizations and advertise the meeting.

Motion by Reed, second by Moniz to approve Resolution 2020-05-07 "Approving Access, Construction and Communications Easement Agreement" with Interstate Cablevision, LLC (OmniTel) until closing on the property at 512 N. Highway St. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Mayor Miller stated the park playground will be reopening on June 1<sup>st</sup> but will not be disinfected, so play at your own risk. Restrooms will remain closed for the time being and if youth sports schedule games they may check out a key for the restrooms during scheduled games only.

Motion by Perkins, second by Moniz to adjourn. 5 ayes, motion carried.
