SPECIAL SESSION

The Special Session of the Oakland City Council met at the City Services Building and was called to order by Mayor Brant Miller at 5:02p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Council Members present were Applegate, Bernard, Ford, and Perkins. Also present were City Administrator/Clerk Marissa Lockwood, Marvin Godden, and Marlyn Von Weihe.

Motion by Bernard to approve the agenda. Second by Applegate. 4 ayes, motion carried.

Miller opened the public hearing concerning the fiscal year 2027 proposed max property tax levy at 5:02p.m. Miller stated the proposed max property tax levy is \$10.84866 which is less than half a cent increase over last year. Godden expressed that he feels the residents are being overtaxed. Miller shared tax levies from last year for all towns in Pottawattamie County and Oakland sits in the lower half of the city levy rates. Von Weihe asked if the water projects are funded using the tax levy funds, Miller explained that water projects are funded with water revenue funds. Public hearing was closed at 5:08p.m.

Motion by Perkins, second by Applegate to adjourn. 4 ayes, motion carried.
