## OAKLAND CITY COUNCIL SEPTEMBER 9, 2024 REGULAR SESSION

The Regular Session of the Oakland City Council met in the Oakland City Services Building and was called to order by Mayor Brant Miller (electronically) at 7:00p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Council Members present were Applegate, Bernard, Moniz, Perkins, and Reed. City staff present were City Administrator/Clerk Marissa Lockwood and Interim Public Works Director Josh Billings. No public present. Motion by Moniz, second by Applegate to approve the agenda. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Open forum was held. No public comments.

Motion by Bernard to approve the consent agenda including August Clerk Report, September Claims, August Library Report, August Golf Course Report, August Sheriff's Report, minutes from August 12<sup>th</sup> regular session, August fire department minutes and liquor license for Taylor Quik Pik. Second by Moniz. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning the ash trees along Dr. Van Zee Rd. and the highway at the south end of town. Right of way maintenance is the adjacent property owner's responsibility. Bids were reviewed to have the trees removed. Motion by Bernard, second by Moniz to offer a 50/50 cost share with each of the property owners to have the ash trees removed along Dr. Van Zee Rd. and South Highway. 4 ayes, motion carried. Reed abstained due to conflict of interest.

Personnel discussion was held. Motion by Perkins, second by Reed to approve Resolution 2024-09-01 "Setting Employee Wages" giving Breanna Chappell an increase of 4.5%, taking her salary to \$35,651.20. Roll call. 5 ayes, motion carried. Sick leave payout for Kris Bramman was discussed due to no mention of payout upon death in the Employee Handbook. Motion by Reed, second by Applegate to approve payment of remaining 224.75 hours of sick leave in the amount of \$9,983.40 pretax. 5 ayes, motion carried.

Billings gave the Crew Report. North water tower is empty and welders have started on the stand pipe replacement. Pool is drained and will be winterized soon. Asphalt street repairs are completed, Walnut Street concrete repair will be completed soon.

Lockwood gave the Clerk's Report. Audit will be the end of October or first of November. Lockwood and Bernard will be attending Iowa League of Cities Annual Conference next week. Update on annexation and wells projects. Pool committee will meet with Waters Edge on Monday, September 16<sup>th</sup>. Completing documentation to submit to Board of Supervisors to have the \$125,00 loan for the amphitheater and golf course improvements forgiven.

Miller gave the Mayor's Report. Homecoming is this week. Working on Public Works Director job description and organization chart. Update on the blue substance reported by the DNR, still unknown what it is.
